Fees should be paid directly to the student's school, and are shown below. Fees are reduced or waived for economically disadvantaged students. Please contact your child's school if you wish to apply for a waiver.

Athletics	Required of every student participating in VHSL sports. Payment of fees does not guarantee playing time.	\$75.00
Consumable Materials	Required of every student and is used to purchase consumable supplies and materials used by students each year.	\$15.00
Physical Education Uniform, Grades 8-10	Recommended of students enrolled in physical education, weight training and/or advanced conditioning. Uniforms may be purchased from school(s).	\$20.00
Art, Pottery or Crafts, Grades 7-12	Required of students enrolling in a fine arts course for art supplies.	\$15.00
Music, Grades 6-12	Required of students enrolling in Chorus, Choir, or Ensemble courses for music, costumes and supplies.	\$15.00
Music, Grades 6-8	Required of students enrolling in band courses for music and supplies.	\$35.00
Music, Grades 6-8	Required for 6th grade students and new 7th and 8th students enrolling in band courses for the first time for uniforms.	\$20.00
Music, Grades 9-12	Required of students enrolling in band courses for uniforms.	\$50.00
Technology Education, Grades 6-12	Required of students enrolling in Technology Education courses for consumable materials.	\$15.00
Business Education	Required of students enrolling in Business Education courses for supplies.	\$5.00
Family & Consumer Science, Grades 9-12	Required of students enrolling in FACS classes for supplies.	\$15.00
Health and Medical Sciences, Grades 9-12	Required of students enrolled in Health and Medical Sciences courses for supplies and field trips.	\$5.00

Class Dues	Recommended for each high school student to assist with specific class functions, such as end-of-year events, prom, and graduation	\$5.00-\$20.00

Test Fees	Students pay for the cost of SAT and Advanced Placement Tests.	Amount determined by testing organization
Club Fees	Several Clubs at high school. Annual dues vary.	\$15.00-\$20.00

Official Transcripts, former	Provided when requested for former students.	\$3.00
